** THE HIGHEST LEVEL OF HEALTH FACILITIES IN THE REPUBLIC OF THE MARSHALL ISLANDS IS PREMISED ON INTERNATIONAL CATEGORIZATIONS OF HEALTHCARE OFFERING; PRIMARY CARE, LEVEL ONE, LEVEL TWO, LEVEL THREE AND SPECIALTY HOSPITAL SERVICES. COMMUNITIES ACROSS RMI HAVE ACCESS TO LOCAL DISPENSARIES THAT PROVIDE PRIMARY HEALTHCARE THROUGH BASIC MEDICAL TREATMENT BY DOCTORS AND NURSES. THERE ARE TWO NATIONAL HOSPITALS IN RMI SUPPORTING LEVEL TWO HEALTH CARE SERVICES THAT OFFER BASIC MEDICAL TREATMENT AS WELL AS GENERAL SURGICAL PROCEDURES
