

Key Findings

States in the northern and southern most parts of Palau have varying capacity, resources, funding, and awareness about emergency preparedness status/level. Overall, HCC was able to uniquely identify individual state needs from inputs gathered from the communities. The following are the needs expressed by community members:

1. Limited to no emergency alert/warning systems for northern/southern most parts of Palau
2. Limited to no high surf advisory warning for Peleliu, Angaur, Kayangel, and Ngeremlengui
3. No radio frequency for northern/southernmost parts of Palau
4. No evacuation plans to accommodate people living with specific medical conditions
5. Limited to no access to shelters for people with access and functional needs

Individual findings from the various evaluations are highlighted below.

Recommendations

1. Assist in development of state-level emergency/evacuation plans and procedures to include plans for people living with specific access and functional needs
2. Improve radio frequency to enable northern/southern most parts of Palau to receive radio transmission and or using variety of systems to deliver warning and alerts to increase community coverage
3. Effective and interoperable communication systems to allow seamless communications during an emergency
4. Improve evacuation shelters to accommodate people with access and functional needs
5. Continue to strengthen individual and community resilience
6. Train, equip, and support state government to manage moderate level events
7. Promote broader engagement of the state government, private sectors, and individuals to build resilience and share the responsibility for readiness and mitigation
